Maths

Number: multiplication and division (fractions linked) *solve one-step problems involving multiplication and division, by calculating the answer using concrete objects, pictorial representations and arrays with the support of the teacher *recognise, find and name a half as 1 of 2 equal parts of an object, shape or quantity *recognise, find and name a quarter as 1 of 4 equal parts of an object, shape or quantity *through grouping and sharing small quantities, pupils begin to understand: multiplication and division; doubling numbers and quantities; and finding simple fractions of objects, numbers and quantities. **Measurement:** volume and capacity *compare capacity and volume [for example, full/empty, more than, less than, half, half full, quarter] *Measurement and begin to record capacity and volume.
